PAPER ENTRIES OPEN ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2019, at 9:00 AM EST and should be mailed to the trial secretary. Any paper entries received before February 15, 2019, will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed.

ALL ENTRIES CLOSE ON FRIDAY, MARCH 15, 2019, at 12:00 PM EDT, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

TWO DAYS, TWO TRIALS, REGISTRATION LIMIT OF 125 ENTRIES PER TRIAL

ENTRY METHOD: FIRST RECEIVED, WITH VOLUNTEER PREFERENCE – Paper entries will be entered by hand at least once per week in the order in which they were received until the registration limit is reached. Paper entries with a legible email address will be acknowledged by email. Entry order preference will be given to the volunteers who work the trial.

WAITING LIST INFORMATION – For these trials, Sarasota Obedience Training Club is offering a Waiting List to fill openings created by entries which are withdrawn after the trial's closing. A maximum of 25 entries per trial will be placed on the Waiting List. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial's closing. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the Waiting List into the trial will receive a full refund. Withdrawn entries that are not replaced by a wait-listed entry will not receive a refund.

**The A/B Sections:** The Novice A class is for beginners. Those dogs who have earned a title in that element (in AKC or in another organization), and those handlers who have worked as professional detection dog handlers must enter the B section. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/divisions. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

**Levels:** Dogs that have previously earned the same or higher level AKC Scent Work titles may enter lower level classes. Dogs are eligible to enter up to two (2) difficulty levels in each element, in each trial.

**Order of Classes:** The order of classes and the judging schedule will be determined after entries have closed and will be sent by email to entrants who have provided a legible email address. Judging begins at 9:00 AM each day.

#### CLASS TRANSFERS

Any request for a move-up or other class transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. The Trial Secretary will have forms available for transfer requests.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

Three High-In-Trial awards will be offered—one each for the Novice, Advanced, and Excellent levels. Only teams who participate in all elements offered at a level and who qualify in each are eligible to win a High-In-Trial award. Only one High-In-Trial winner will be chosen per level. There is no separate High-In-Trial award for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The High-In-Trial winner is determined by adding each team's faults across the elements. The team with the fewest faults is the winner. If there is a tie based on faults, then each team's times across the elements will be summed, and the fastest-finishing team will win.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, have Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), are enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program, or are recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS). Wherever the word "dog" is used herein it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

**HANDLER DISCRIMINATION ARTICLES**

For all entries in Handler Discrimination classes, the handler is required to provide the scented article. For the Novice Handler Discrimination class, the handler must provide a cotton glove or cotton sock. For the Advanced Handler Discrimination classes, the handler must provide a cotton ball or cotton swab. The article(s) should be thoroughly scented by the handler and brought to the trial site sealed in a plastic bag to be hidden on the course.

**SEARCH AREAS AND WEATHER CONDITIONS**

All Container, all Interior, and the Novice Buried and Advanced Buried classes will take place indoors on matted, carpeted, tiled, or concrete surfaces. All Exterior and the Excellent Buried classes will take place outdoors. Therefore handlers should be prepared for all potential weather conditions. Handlers should understand that outdoor searches will be conducted rain or shine, unless dangerous conditions are present (such as lightning or flooding). Comfortable footwear and water-resistant clothing are recommended.

**WARM-UP AREA**

A warm-up area will be available consisting of one labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day and may also consist of blank containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

**RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES**

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue  
Second Place.....Red  
Third Place.....Yellow

**HANDLER'S BRIEFING**

The first Handler's Briefing will take place at 9:00 AM each day with the first dog in that class and element to run immediately thereafter. A Handler's Briefing will take place in view of the search area(s) prior to the start of each class. In the Handler's Briefing, the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, the search area(s), the number of hides, the maximum height of hides, and the maximum time for the search in that class and element. No dogs may be present during the Handler's Briefing.

## TRIAL SITE INFORMATION

**Trial Site:** It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

**Spectator Area:** Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

**Crating space** will be available indoors in air conditioning. Any dog left alone in the crating area must be crated. Crates may be left overnight; however, Sarasota Obedience Training Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site. No dogs may be left overnight on the grounds of the trial site.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. These areas are not for training or relieving of the dog.

## NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

**Judges are not required to wait** for dogs to be brought to the search area when required. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having their dog ready when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public-address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs

**Possession of Odors and Training:** Owner/handlers may not be in possession of any target odor on the grounds of the trial site. There shall be no training on the grounds of the trial site, other than the designated warm-up area.

## SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, AND LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.

**Aggressive or Disruptive Behavior:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or

disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**Liability:** Sarasota Obedience Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. SOTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against SOTC or any official thereof.

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses:** Dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

**Sarasota Obedience Training Club not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

## REFUNDS

**No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

**Withdrawals:** For bitches in season pulled after closing, the owner/handler must submit a written or emailed request to receive a refund of entry fees. For dogs pulled after closing due to injury or other medical condition, the owner/handler must submit a written or emailed statement from their vet as to the dog's condition to receive a refund of entry fees. Such withdrawal notifications must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class on the first day the dog is entered in the trial to be eligible for a refund of entry fees. See WAITING LIST INFORMATION above for additional refund information.

**SHOW SITE DIRECTIONS:** Take I-75 to Exit #217 (State Route 70 East). Go east on State Route 70. Turn left (north) on County Road 675. (just passed Tree-Umph). At the stop sign bear left and SOTC is the red building on your right.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed.
