



Dear Exhibitor,

Please find enclosed your entry confirmation, judging schedule and other pertinent information for SOTC's Obedience & Rally Trials August 19-20, 2017. The rings will have a slightly different layout this year. Please consult the enclosed Judging Schedule for ring assignments.

Please note the following:

- All exhibitors need to review all information for their entry (s) and report immediately to the Trial Secretary any corrections to be made. Please note that the Trial Secretary is not available Friday evening as she is in route to the trial. - **All move-ups for Saturday, August 19th** MUST be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than Tuesday Aug 15th by 6:00 pm. No move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this date.
- **All move-ups for Sunday, August 20th** MUST be submitted to the Trial Secretary BEFORE the close of the Trial on Saturday the 19th. **No move-ups for Sunday will be allowed after this time.**
- Please clean up after your dogs. There is an exercise area in the back of the building over by Ring #1. Please be respectful of the Rally and Novice exhibitors showing in ring one as you and your canine partner make your way to the exercise area.
- Judges are not required to wait for any dog. We have a total of **343** entries for the weekend and ask that everyone be ready ringside when your # is up. Should you have a conflict you are responsible for getting with the Gate Stewards/or Judge to let them know of your conflict.
- All dogs must be either on leash or contained in a crate when not in the show ring. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR DOG UNATTENDED FOR ANY LENGTH OF TIME. YOU NEED TO BE IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO YOUR DOG SHOULD THEY NEED YOUR ASSISTANCE.**
- **THERE IS NO SET-UP FRIDAY NIGHT.** Please bring crates that are stackable as crating space is limited. There are crates available by students at the club who are not using those crates. Please be respectful of their crates and leave them in the same condition as you found them. No x-pens are allowed inside the building. As crating space is limited, exhibitors are asked to abide by the rules for the spaces allowed.
- **Judges will take a lunch break at their discretion.**
- Overnight camping is allowed in the parking lot; however there are no hook-ups or dumping on the show site. This will be at your "own risk" as there will not be any security on duty.
- The doors will open at **7:00 am** both Saturday and Sunday mornings.
- **IMPORTANT** Parking information: **Absolutely No Parking In Front Of The Furniture Business Or The Gymnastics Building. They Will Have You Towed Away** (New Owners-New Policies) Please observe the parking parameters of the Dog Club. Please know that you are responsible for parking in the proper area. You will run the risk of being towed if you are parked in their "parking zone"
- **Directions to the show site:** I-275 to Exit #25 (38 Ave North); go west on 38th Ave; turn right (north) on 34th St North (US 19)-(Hardees on the left); go over the overpass and turn left into Nationwide Furniture parking lot. The Dog Club building is located to the left of the Furniture Building.
- **There is absolutely NO practicing in the rings at ANY time nor is food allowed in the rings at any time.**

- **Two-Day catalogues may be purchased from the Trial Secretary for \$5.00.** Pre-paid catalogs may be picked up at the front office from the Trial Secretary either day of the trial.
- **Reminder to all Jr. Handlers, PAL/ILP dogs/handlers:** High Scoring Jr Handler, ILP/PAL must sign up ahead of time to be eligible for these awards at the Ribbon Table.
- The Obedience Trial will be open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm both Saturday and Sunday. You will be allowed to leave your chairs/crates set up overnight on Saturday.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- BITCHES IN SEASON Entry fee minus \$5.00 per day entered will be refunded for bitches that come in season after the close of the trial. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.
- **Food will not be available at this trial for exhibitors, however there are a number of eateries in close proximity to the club.**
