Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placements.

ANY DOG WHO FINISHES A TITLE WILL RECEIVE A SPECIAL TITLE ROSETTE

QUALIFYING SCORE is required for all awards in all Classes.

A Bar and Rosette will also be awarded for any team earning their

Master Agility Championship OR Preferred Agility Championship.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Ring size is 100' x 100' on packed dirt

Note: This club does not wish to arbitrate

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Sarasota Obedience Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Sarasota Obedience Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Sarasota Obedience Training Club or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. **Bitches In Season** Entry fee minus \$5.00 per day entered will be refunded for bitches that come in season after the close of the trial. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RUNNING ORDER

Consult your final confirmation for the exact running order and start times for each ring.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Dogs requiring a height measurement must be measured before they run. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CRATING

Crating is allowed on Friday afternoon. Please contact the Fair Grounds for times to enter the grounds. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Sarasota Obedience Training Club the Manatee County Fair will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

MOVE – UPS Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an Agility title provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing either by email or snail mail by Monday Nov 30th at 6pm. Move ups for Sunday, Dec 6th, must be made by the close of the trial on Saturday. No move-ups accepted either morning.

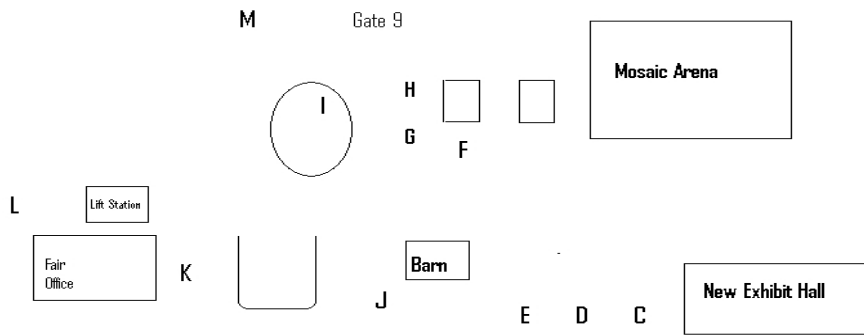

In order to better serve you we have made some changes which will begin in October of 2010. Each power box on the fairgrounds will be designated with a letter. Please review the map and legend to make selections for potential camping sites. Each power box has a different configuration of 30 and 50 amp services. In the space provided make your top three (3) preferences or select "No Preference". Camping spots will be allocated as reservations are received in the fair office. Campers not making reservations may have to wait for availability.

- Power Box C- Two (2) 30 Amp Services with Water
- Power Box D-Two (2) 50 Amp Services and One (1) 30 Amp Service with Water
- Power Box E- One (1) 50 Amp Service and One (1) 30 Amp Service with Water
- Power Box F- Eight (8) 30 Amp Services with Water
- Power Box G- Two (2) 50 Amp Services with Water
- Power Box H- Two (2) 50 Amps Services with Water
- Power Box I- Eight (8) 30 Amp Services and One (1) 50 Amp Service with Water
- Power Box J- Three (3) 50 Amp Services with Water
- Power Box K- Seven (7) 50 Amp Services with Water
- Power Box L- Eighteen (18) 50 Amp Services and Six (6) 30 Amp Services with Water
- Power Box M- Eight (8) 50 Amp Services with **No Water**

- No Saving Spots - come together if you want to camp together. No Cones or roping off of areas - Cones and ropes will be confiscated

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
