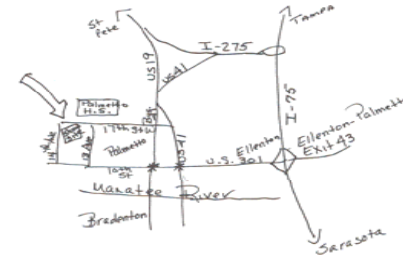

ABOUT OUR TRIAL SITE

The trial site is a covered Arena! Packed dirt ring surfaces, each ring 100' x 110'. Permanent bleachers for spectators, concrete floored crating space, plus restrooms, all under the arena's roof. Grass for screen rooms just beyond the roofed area, if you prefer to set them up. Overnight RV parking with electric & water hookups (no sewer). Spaces with hookups are limited. See the enclosed reservation form.



Directions From I-75: take exit 224 (old #43) onto US 301 westbound. It becomes 10th Street West in Palmetto. Continue to 14th Avenue. (You will cross both US 41/Business 41.) Turn right on 14th (northbound) and continue to the fairground entrance.
From Pinellas County: I-275 south over the Skyway Bridge. (\$1.00 toll). Take exit 5 (US 19) south. Where 19 splits into US 41/Business 41, take the Business 41 branch to the right. Turn right onto 17th Street in Palmetto. Turn left onto 14th Ave and continue to Fairground entrance.

MOVE – UPS

Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an Agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing. All Move ups for March 27th must be submitted in writing to the Trial Secretary, either by email or snail mail, by Monday March 22nd @ 6:00 PM. Move ups for Sunday March 28th MUST BE submitted by the close of the Trial on Saturday. NO MOVE UPS WILL BE TAKEN EITHER MORNING.

Overnight entries must be marked "No Signature Required"

Entry Fee Schedule Is As Follows:

1st Class = \$20.00 per dog per day
2nd Class = \$12.00 per dog per day

Example:

One dog entered in Std/JWW/FAST **Saturday** = \$44.00 total
One dog entered in Std/JWW **both** days = \$64.00 total
One dog entered in Std/FAST **one** day = \$32.00 total
If only entered in one class each day, the fee is \$40.00 total (\$20.00 per day)

YOU CAN NOW ENTER THE TRIAL VIA AKC'S ONLINE ENTRY SERVICE

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your 'My AKC' account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 25% online entries (83 runs) and 75% paper entries (247). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placements.

ANY DOG WHO FINISHES A TITLE WILL RECEIVE A SPECIAL ROSETTE

QUALIFYING SCORE is required for all awards in Regular Classes.

A Bar and Rosette will also be awarded for any team earning their Master Agility Championship.

All awards not picked up by the exhibitor(s) become the property of SOTC

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Notice to ALL Exhibitors: if a height card is not provided at time of entry you will need to be measured or show your height card BEFORE you are allowed to run with the exception of those jumping 24" or 26" (unless there is a VMO or AKC Representative at the trial for 24" & 26" dogs only). If you have a height card please include a copy of the card stapled to the back of each entry. This includes 24" & 26" dogs with a height card. Check in packets for those without a height card provided ahead of time will have to be picked up at the Trial Secretary Table. This will be enforced.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

The trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC or ILP numbers as a registered breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of breeds that may participate. **DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

"This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event."

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Bitches that come in season after the closing of entries will be allowed a refund, minus \$20 for weekend, provided the Trial Secretary has written notice prior to the trial.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
